

WikiSuite vs Zoho

WikiSuite can be seen as a FLOSS

self-hosted alternative to Zoho Suite.

Similarities

- Both are full-featured platforms, with a high level of integration to manage organizational data
- Both share the goal of breadth and depth of features

Differences

- Zoho is proprietary SaaS while WikiSuite is free / Libre / Open Source software.
